#### **ESTABLISHING A CARBON POLLUTION BASELINE**

Vail Health has embarked on numerous pollution reduction projects over the past several years, including reducing landfill waste, increasing composting, and participating in Vail Village and State of Colorado energy reduction projects. Establishing a carbon pollution baseline was essential to their future data-driven efforts.

In March 2024, Vail Health partnered with SION60 to establish a carbon emissions baseline, identifying opportunities to reduce their pollution. SION60 and Vail completed an interface to Energy Star Portfolio Manager to automatically interface data from facility energy invoices. Anesthesia, gas and fleet fuel consumption were also measured. SION60's software, built on the foundation of the Greenhouse Protocol, EPA and Joint Commission standards, simplified difficult measurements.

**RESULTS:** This analysis confirmed and highlighted the opportunity to focus pollution-reducing projects on Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions. Vail Health now has the data to measure their impact moving forward.

#### **RETROFIT PROJECTS**

Vail Health reviewed 18 energy-saving retrofit projects automatically generated by SION60's software. Vail Health is currently evaluating the projects against Colorado's state energy reduction requirements, and is proceeding forward with several they have identified as reducing energy consumption.
